




- Figure 1. A schematic diagram of the experimental setup for the measurement of the absorption coefficient of the sample.





General Evaluation Configuration

| Category | Setting | Description |
|--------------------|--|---|
| Model Type | Text Generation | Generates text based on input prompts. |
| Input Text | "Hello, world!" | The starting text for the generation process. |
| Temperature | 0.7 | A value between 0.0 and 1.0 that controls the randomness of the generated text. |
| Max Length | 100 | The maximum number of tokens to generate. |
| Sampling Method | Nucleus Sampling | Chooses tokens based on their probability and a nucleus size. |
| Top K | 50 | Keeps the top K most probable tokens for each step. |
| Top P | 0.9 | Keeps tokens with cumulative probabilities up to p. |
| Repetition Penalty | 1.2 | Penalty applied to tokens that have been used recently. |
| Length Penalty | 1.0 | Penalty applied to tokens based on their length. |
| Min Length | 50 | The minimum number of tokens to generate. |
| Stop Sequences | " | Sequences to stop generating if found. |
| Padding Token | " " | The token used for padding. |
| Padding Length | 0 | The length of padding. |
| Output Format | Text | The format of the output generated text. |
| Output Length | 100 | The length of the output text. |
| Output Text | "Hello, world! The quick brown fox jumps over the lazy dog." | The final generated text. |
