

SEPARATED MILITARY PERSONNEL OUT OF STATE TUITION DIFFERENTIAL WAIVER

A student may be eligible for the Separated Military Out-of-State Tuition Waiver if they meet one of the following conditions:

A) an individual who within thirty-six (36) months has separated from active-duty military service and enrolls in an academic program and demonstrates intent to become domiciled in Georgia. This waiver may also be granted to their spouses and dependent children if the military member is physically residing in Georgia.

B) any separated service member or any student utilizing transferred VA educational benefits and physically residing in the state.

C) Any individual as described in 38 U.S.C. 3679(c).

Please complete the following section:

The student may retain the waiver every semester after the waiver is approved provided the student remains continuously enrolled. If a student does not register for two consecutive semesters following their last enrolled semester at KSU the waiver will be removed. If the student returns to KSU, the student can reapply for the waiver or petition to change their tuition classification if they are eligible.

Students will have until 30 days after the first day of the term to apply for this waiver. No applications will be accepted past that date. No retroactive changes will be considered for prior terms or fiscal years.
