What are the awardees' responsibilities?

If you are granted a NFLP loan, you must:

Maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Sign a promissory note every semester you receive funding.

Follow the application procedures for each year continued funding is desired, as required by HRSA.

Fulfill the NFLP commitment and obligations, which includes continued progression consistent with the approved program of study.
